8. METHODS FOR VERIFYING LEARNING AND FOR EVALUATION

Philosophy and theology: from speaking of God, to speaking with God, to speaking in God. Introduction to the Sacred Scriptures of Jews and Christians: a historical journey with the Bible from the First Testament monolatry to Trinitarian monotheism. Approach to the Christology of the New Testament. The mystery of the incarnation of the Son of God. The paschal mystery of the Son of God: the Crucified and Risen conqueror of sin and death. The fulfillment of the Easter event of the Son of God: the mystery of the Ascension and Pentecost. The essence of the Christian faith as communion of God with men: the mystery of the Church. Critical aspects of the current faith situation of believers. The question of "Christian identity" in today's confrontation with other religions. Current theological issues of general interest to be agreed with students.
